

You can join our activities when it suits you best. However, before the first practice, the team needs information when the player is coming to the practice – inform the team management either by adding the information in the MyClub comment field, or by notifying the team's head coach directly.

You can get to know our activities freely and free of charge for two weeks. After that please let the team know does the player join the team or not.

**EQUIPMENT** (for the first practice) NOTE! The exercises will be reached in time about 15 minutes before the announced start time

- Sportswear according to the weather (eg windbreaker, sweatshirts, etc.)
- Sneakers or football boots
- Own ball (if you have)
- Water bottle (already filled with water)
- The player is responsible for equipment purchases (training and matc kit, personal equipments)

## AFTER JOINED TO VJS

- The club VJS is responsible for administrative matters and the team for all matters related to playing. Please notice: the club consists several teams.
- Invoicing will start after you have confirmed to join the team. Team-specific operating fees can be found at <a href="https://vjs.fi/tuupelaa/">https://vjs.fi/tuupelaa/</a>. The <a href="team activity fee">team activity fee</a> is divided into monthly installments, which are invoiced on the 1st day of each month, except the November's and December's fees will be invoiced with one invoice in December.
- **VJS's membership fee** and the **club's operating fee** will be billed each year.
- For team events not included in the operating fee (e.g. camps, tournaments, travel expenses, etc.), the player will be billed separately. There is separate registration for these events.
- According to the rules of the Football Association, the player must have a <u>valid insurance</u> policy. For children under 12, it is included in the operating fee. From the year a player turns 12, he is responsible for the insurance himself (or the player's guardians). For over 12s, the Football Association's partner's insurance can be registered (the Football Association's payment link will be sent to the guardian for payment), unless announcement of the player's own insurance has been submitted (to <u>vjs@vjs.fi</u>).
- If a player transfers from another club and has had a players' licence (Pelipassi) in the current or
  previous season, the player will be charged the <u>registration fee</u> charged by the Football Association
  for the transfer of the right of representation (the Football Association's payment link will be sent to

- NOTE! If the rules of the series require insurance and it is obtained through the club, both the insurance and the registration fee for the right of representation (previous paragraph) must be paid before the first official match. Failure to pay will result in players's status (=unregistered), which may have an impact on the results of the team's matches, as well as a penalty payment.
